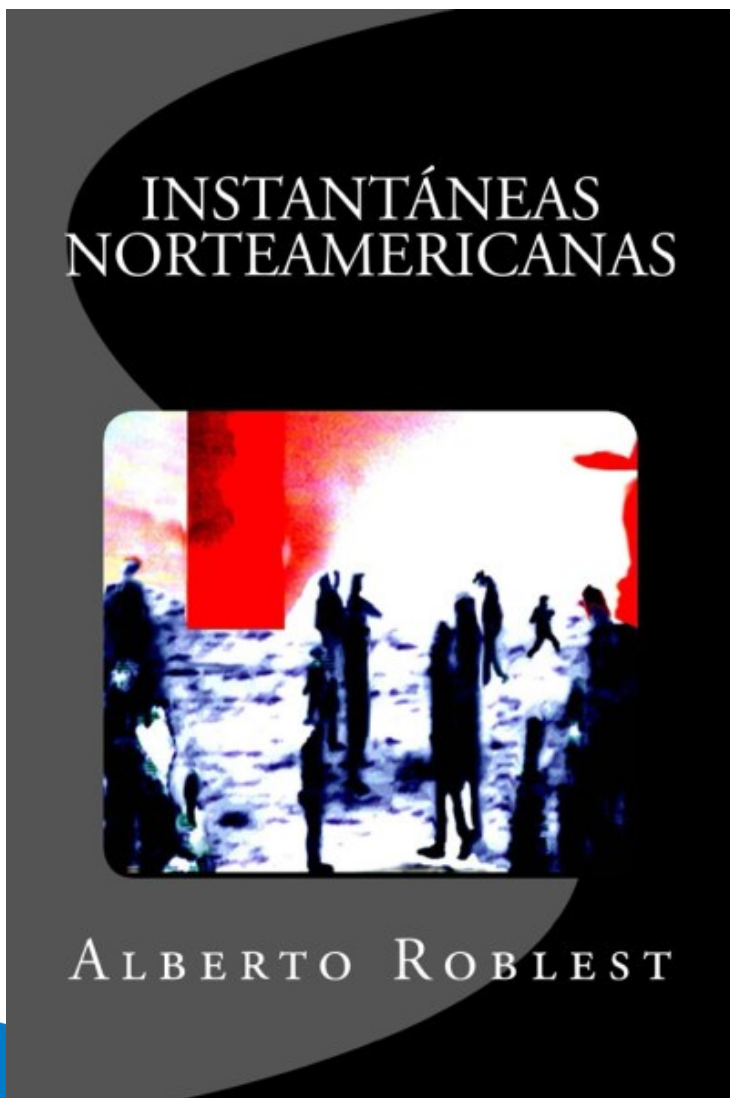


DC Public Library presents
